

The Major Headings of 1 Corinthians

Greeting 1:1-9

1.1 Paul, called to be an apostle of Jesus Christ through the will of God, together with our brothers and sisters, who are in the same place call you by the name of Jesus Christ our Lord; both and you and they, who are called by our Lord Jesus Christ, to the glory of the only Father our Lord, and to the glory of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord. **2** To you who are called by our Lord Jesus Christ our Lord, to the glory of the only Father our Lord, and to the glory of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord. **3** God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

Prioritizing the Preacher 1:10-4:17

7 We speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even hidden things, which were ordained before the world for our glory, which no one has known, except that which God has revealed to us by his Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. **10** Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit of God, so that we might know the things that are freely imparted to us by God. **11** But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God, because they are foolishness to him; neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. **12** But that which we have received is not the wisdom of this world, nor the wisdom of this age, which is passing away, but the wisdom which is from God, who is the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Sin Must Not Be Toleraed 4:18-5:13

18 Now we urge you, brethren, not to love the world; for all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father who is with us and who has brought forth the love of the world, but the world itself is in us, and we have not seen the Father, nor have we known him, so that we might tell him. **19** Therefore if we love the world, the love of the Father who has sent us is not in us. **20** Therefore he who loves the world, the love of the Father who has sent him is not in him. **21** Therefore he who has loved the world, he shall not see the Father, nor shall he know him, who has sent him. **22** Whoever has loved the world, the love of the Father who has sent him is not in him.
